Catch the *Spirit of Ethan Allen III* for a Sunday evening sunset cruise on Lake Champlain. Relax and enjoy a festive opening banquet as we float between the Adirondack and Green Mountain ranges. Guest speaker will be radio WDEV owner, Ken Squier, antique car hobbyist and nationally recognized race car commentator.
